**RESOLUTION TO HIRE MAYOR'S COURT MAGISTRATE FOR THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RC §1905.01, the Village of Risingsun has established a Mayor's Court known as the Risingsun Mayor's Court; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RC §1905.05, the Mayor of the Village has the authority to appoint a magistrate to hear and determine prosecutions and criminal causes in the mayor's court that are within the jurisdiction of the mayor's court; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order 2021-\_\_\_, the Mayor has appointed Atty. Carl Drew Griffith to act as the Risingsun Mayor's Court Magistrate, effective January 1, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RC 1905.05, the legislative authority of the Village must fix and pay the compensation for such a magistrate; and

**WHEREAS**, Council of the Village of Risingsun has determined that it is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and welfare that the Village enact such regulation.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RISINGSUN, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Council hereby ratifies the appointment of Atty. C. Drew Griffith as the Risingsun Mayor's Court Magistrate.

SECTION 2.

The compensation for anyone acting as Risingsun Mayor's Court Magistrate is hereby fixed at \$150.00 per session of the Mayor's Court over which such magistrate presides.

SECTION 3. Effective Date:

This Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage at the earliest period allowed by Law.

SECTION 4. Emergency Measure:

This resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the immediate


preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Risingsun, and shall go into immediate effect upon the passage thereof. The reason for the emergency is that the Village will be without a magistrate if it is not enacted immediately and, thus, cannot perform the statutory duties and meet the timelines prescribed by law with regard to mayor's courts.

SECTION 5. Public Meetings:

All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action were held in meetings open to the public, as required by Law.


